## Romanian Society of Laboratory Medicine

The Romanian Society of Laboratory Medicine (RSML) is the only scientific, academic society in Romania active in the field of laboratory medicine. It was founded in 2001, and took over the assets of the former SRLC (Romanian Society of Clinical Laboratory, founded in 1993) which, at its turn, continued the activity of the Clinical Laboratory Section, part of the existing Romanian Medical Association.

Over the last years, our association's organization and affiliations evolved to reflect our continuous need and intention to improve our structure and enrich our goals in order to offer to the Romanian specialist in laboratory medicine the best opportunities to enhance their expertise and start international collaborations.

The society counted 215 full members in 2005, from more than 3000 Romanian specialists active in this medical field (physicians, chemists, biologists, biochemists).

We have significant experience in organizing scientific events and exhibitions specialized in laboratory medicine. We have organized so far, besides the twelve annual National Congresses (between 1994 and 2005) and the Balkan Clinical Laboratory Federation - BCLF - Meetings (in 2000 and 2004), the International Danubian Symposium in 2001 and 2005. All these scientific events were accompanied by exhibitions representative for this medical field.

We also had a rich calendar for 2006, as we are the organizers of the following events:

- Second Symposium on Inflammation and Inflammatory Diseases - INFLAMMATION 2006, under the auspices of IFCC (International Federation of Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine) and FESCC (Forum of the European Societies of Clinical Chemistry and Laboratory Medicine); April 6–8, 2006.
- First International Conference "Collateral Effects of Antiinfective Drugs", organized together with the Romanian Society for the Study of Chemotherapy, under the auspices of ISC (The International Society of Chemotherapy); October 4–6, 2006.
- FESCC Symposium for the Balkan Region on Education Management and on Standards in Laboratory Medicine; November 2–5, 2006.
